Daryl explained the changing of the name from Australia Veteran Golfers' Union to Australia Veteran Golfers' Association this 5 will happen in the future. The Association will be moving from Canberra to Western Australia because of legalities.

The new AVGU constitution has been finally approved.

Victoria will hold the Australian Veteran Championships in 2029.

AVGU Championships for 2024/. 332 veterans have entered with 227 men and 105 ladies.

Next year's (2025) AVGU Championships will be held in Darwin.

Item 4/. Item submitted by Geoff Cohen South Gippsland Secretary on the proposed merger of district boundaries by Golf Australia was discussed by delegates present. VVGA President Ern spoke with Mark Bamford Golf Australia representative, and this matter does not affect veterans' golf. (Council to be kept informed)
